

Clinical Care Co-ordination Program Information Sheet

HealthWISE Mental Health Clinical Care Co-ordination program is a confidential clinical service for people with complex mental illness.

The CCC program is offered across the South Burnett region (Kingaroy, Murgon, and Cherbourg) and the Southern Downs region (Warwick and Stanthorpe) funded by the DDWMPHN at no cost.

This program is delivered in partnership with lived experience staff to provide wrap around psychosocial support to people where this service is required.

All HealthWISE Mental Health staff including MH Nurses, Social Workers and Lived Experience staff who provide services under this program are registered or approved providers.

Who can access the program?

People from the age of 16 yrs. across the Southern Downs and South Burnett regions with complex mental illness.

We provide Face to Face, Phone and/or Telehealth consultations.

How to access this program:

Referral to the CCC program requires a Mental Health Treatment/Care Plan from a General Practitioner or Psychiatrist. Fax or email referral to HealthWISE on 1300 452 059 or e-referral via referHEALTH.
